Microsoft Excel - Start and end points in Sparklines

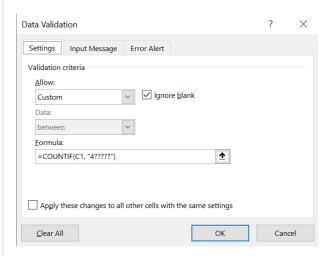
I was at a client recently and they wanted to limit data input in an Excel column to have a number starting with 4 and then five numbers after it.

I have worked out a way of doing this using Data Validation.

First, select the data range to which the data validation rule is to be applied and format it as text - **Home** tab - **Number** group and from the dropdown where it says **General** select **Text**.

Then with the data range still selected, go to the **Data** tab, then in the **Data Tools** group, select **Data Validation**. On the **Settings** tab, from the **Allow** dropdown, select **Custom**.

In the **Formula** box, the formula in this case is **=COUNTIF(C1, "4?????)**, where **C1** is the first cell in the selected range and I want the number to be 4 followed by 5 other numbers.



Click OK.

Although it will be formatted as text, if these are part numbers they are never going to have calculations done on them so works well for data input.

Microsoft Excel - Start and end points in Sparklines

A sparkline is a miniature graph of a data range which can add a useful visual look to your data.

To create a sparkline, click in the cell in which you want the sparkline to be displayed, then on the **Insert** tab, in the **Sparklines** group, select your preferred type of sparkline - **Line**, **Column** or **Win/Loss**. A dialog box will open asking the data range to be used, Select it and click **OK**. you will then see a sparkline of your data.

When I was doing this with a group recently, we had slightly different looks although we were using the same data set. Some looked like they were using an axis that started at 0, others looked like they were just looking at the numbers in the data set itself.

To change this, on the **Sparklines** tab, in the **Sparkline** group, in the **Group** group, click the **Axis** dropdown and for either or both of the **Vertical Axis Minimum Value Options** and **Vertical Axis Maximum Value Options**, select **Custom Value**. Select your required value(s) and click **OK**.
