If Only I'd Known That Blog

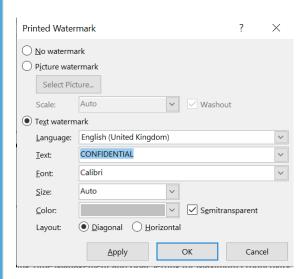
If only I had £50 for every time someone says to me during a training session 'If only I'd known that last week...' So, I have set up a blog with some of the answers that have proved very useful to people. You can see this at http://ifonlyidknownthat.wordpress.com/

Apparently the blog post of mine below had 560 views in July so it must be something that people are struggling with so I though I would reproduce it again here.

For example: Microsoft Word - watermark only appears on the first page

To insert a watermark into a document on the **Design** tab, in the **Page Background** group, click the **Watermark** dropdown and select your required watermark. This will appear on the first page of the document.

If you want it to appear on every page in the document, from the **Watermark** dropdown, click **Custom Watermark**. The **Custom Watermark** dialog box will be displayed.



Click **Text watermark**, from the **Text** dropdown, select your required text, click **Apply**, click **OK**, click **Close**. The watermark will then be displayed on every page of your document.

Microsoft Excel - Icons sets based on specific conditions

I have a client who wanted Red, Amber, Green icon set indicators based on certain conditions.

If H is equal to or greater than J
If H is between 90% and 100% of J
If H is less than 90% of J

The existing data looked something like this:

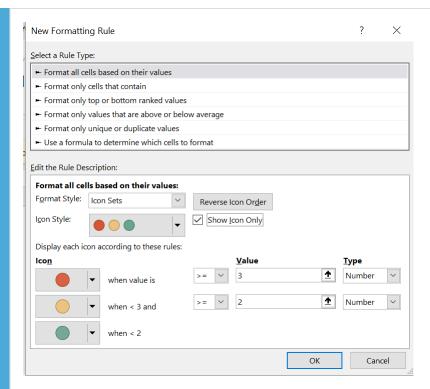

In the next available column I created a nested **IF** statement (I would have used **IFS** but their version of Excel wasn't up to date enough for that!

The formula was: (where row 11 was the first row containing figures)

=IF(H11>J11,1,IF(H11>J11*90%,2,3))

Then with the same cells selected, I went to **Home - Styles - Conditional Formatting - New Rule**.



I selected Format all cells based on their values and lower down the dialog box, selected Reverse Icon Order and Show Icon Only. From the Type dropdown boxes I selected Number. For the first I chose >= 3. For the second I chose >= 2. I then clicked OK.
