# Microsoft Excel - Using VSTACK and HSTACK

If you have several sets of data in an Excel worksheet with similar headings and you want to combine them into a single vertical array, you can use the **VSTACK** function.

The **VSTACK** function can also be used to convert several columns of data into one single column.

Similarly, the **HSTACK** function can be used to merge data horizontally.

Say I have data like below:



There are sales figures for three sales teams and I want these all aligned vertically. The formula would be:

# =VSTACK(A1:B9,D2:E9,G2:H9)
