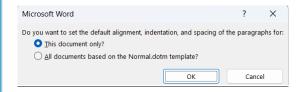
## Microsoft Word - changing default paragraph spacing

If you use the Normal style in Microsoft Word, in Office 365,by default this is set as leaving 8pt after each paragraph and multiple line spacing of 1.16 every time the **Enter** key is pressed. If you would always like to go to the next line when you press the **Enter** key you can change the default paragraph spacing.

Open Microsoft Word. On the **Home** tab, in the **Paragraph** group, click the **Quick Launch dialog box** arrow. The **Paragraph** dialog box is displayed.

In the **Spacing** section, select the required **Before** and **After** paragraph spacing. Click **Default**.

You will receive a message tasking whether you want to change the defaults just for this document or for All documents based on the Normal.dotm template. Make your choice then click **OK**.



If you don't want to change the default but don't want a space between paragraphs, on the **Home** tab, in the **Style** group, select **No Spacing**.

#### Microsoft Excel - the TAKE function

If you have a data table or array in Excel that you are adding to every day, you may want to find the total turnover over the last seven days or the average rainfall over the last week or your average blood pressure over the last 10 days.

This is where the **TAKE** function, usually in combination with another function such as **SUM** or **AVERAGE** comes in hand.

The syntax for the **TAKE** function is:

# =TAKE(array, rows, [columns])

where array is the data set that you are working with, rows is the number of rows to be selected and columns (optional) is the number of columns to be selected.

A positive number of rows starts from the top and takes the first so many down, a negative number starts from the bottom and works upwards.

Consider the following data set which I have converted into table Takings.

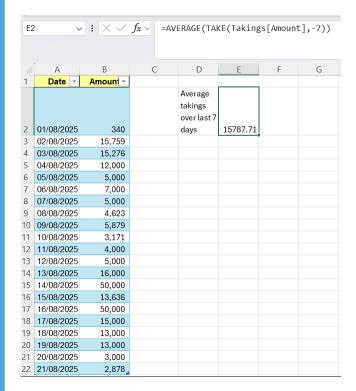


I want to find the average takings over the last seven days.

The formula would be:

**=AVERAGE(TAKE(Takings[Amount],-7))** (Selecting the table will insert **Takings[#All,-7)** 

This gives me the answer as:



Now if I add the next day's data, the result changes accordingly.
